**1 Purpose**

Delay in the start date has been due to wider funding considerations for the project and a delayed submission for planning permission. Planning permission for the site support compound was submitted on 15 September 2022.

**4.1 Financial and Resources**

4.1.1 A further 8 months loss of earning is estimated at £13,500. This loss of earning would need to be factored into the 2024/25 budget.
