Grant	Notes
Small Business Grant (SBG) Scheme- closed 30 September 2020	One off payment for businesses receiving Small Business Rate Relief operating at 11 March 2020.
Retail, Hospitality and Leisure Grant (RHLG) Scheme- closed 30 September 2020	One off payment for businesses in these sectors qualifying for Expanded Retail Discount, with RV under £51k and operating at 11 March 2020.
Local Discretionary Grant Scheme - closed 30 September 2020	For small and micro businesses with fixed property costs not eligible for SBG or RHLG
Local Restrictions Support Grant (Closed i.e. Businesses required to close) 5 November 2020- 2 December 2020	For businesses required to close between 5 November 2020- 2 December 2020
Local Restrictions Support Grant (Closed i.e. Businesses required to close) Post 2 December 2020*	Ongoing support for businesses required to close post 2 December 2020 under Tier 2
Local Restrictions Support Grant (Open i.e. Businesses able to remain open)	Provides financial support to businesses linked to hospitality, hotel, B&B and leisure sectors that have remained open, but have been severely affected by the tiered local restrictions from 14 October 2020- 4 November 2020 and 2 December 2020 onwards (stops in lockdown as LRSB Closed applies)
Additional Restrictions Grant	Businesses who do not qualify for the Local Restrictions Support Grants, such as Supply Chain Businesses severely impacted because they wholly or exclusively supply businesses in hospitality accommodation
Christmas Support Payment	For 'wet-led' pubs. Supports pubs that predominantly serve alcohol rather than provide food and have been severely affected over the festive period due to temporary local restrictions
Local Restrictions Support Grant Sectors	Businesses that have been required to close nationally since 23rd March 2020 in all 314 business rate billing local authorities
Local Restrictions Support Grant (Closed - Addendum Tier 4)	Businesses that are required to close under Tier 4 restrictions from 31 December 2020 to 4 January 2021
Local Restrictions Support Grant (Closed- Addendum Post 5th Jan 2021)	Businesses that are required to close due to national lockdown which came into effect on 5th January 2021
Closed Businesses Lockdown Payment	Businesses which have been supported with a one-off payment through the closed Business Lockdown Payment Scheme
Local Council Tax Reduction Hardship Grant	Council Tax bill reduced by up to a further £300 for working age people receiving Council Tax Reduction.
Restart Grants Strand 1	Grants of up to £6,000 for non-essential retail businesses to help them reopen safely.
Restart Grants Strand 2	Grants of up to £18,000 for hospitality, accommodation, leisure, personal care and gym business premises to help them reopen safely
